The 18th Eishinkan Jodo Team Competition will be held on Saturday 3rd December 2016 at the Kenmukan Dojo (Mill Mead Hall, Haversham Road, Wolverton, Milton Keynes, Buckinghamshire, MK12 5TN).

Doors will open at 10.am and we should be away by 4pm. The Taikai should be completed by early afternoon and all are welcome to attend the lunch afterwards. Feel free to bring your own liquid refreshments, cakes, nibbles etc.

We really hope that some 5th Dan Jodoka will take this opportunity to brush up on their refereeing skills instead of joining a team, however they are welcome to compete if they prefer.

There will be a small gift for everyone taking part but we cannot unfortunately cover expenses for referees as we try to keep the entry fee as low as possible.

The format and rules are the same as for the European Team Championships i.e. 3 players with a maximum of 10 dan. Mudan count the same as shodan, (i.e. one dan). The kata will be those forms from the ZNKR Seitei Jodo. Kata will be chosen from the first 7 forms.

Teams not progressing to the tournament stage will be entered into the Plate Competition.

Please note that this is a dojo event and we hope that as many teams as possible will be from the **same Dojo**.

The cost of entering each team is £30 but we offer a discount of £5:00 if payment is received by November 14th. Each dojo may enter as many teams as it wishes. If you have any questions, please contact Chris (details above). It would greatly help if teams & referees register as soon as possible so that the gifts for participants (sanka-sho) can be organised.

Please let Chris know, by telephone or e-mail, before November 7th if your Dojo will be entering a team. Entry fees should be paid by November 14th if you wish to take advantage of the early booking discount. Entry form & cheque (payable to Mr C.A. Buxton) should be sent to the above address.
