Dear Jodobu Members,

We would like to invite you to the BKA Jodo Kangeiko 2022, hosted with the help of Kenmukan dojo. The event will be held at Millmead Hall, Wolverton. This year we will also include a grading for ikkyu. As usual, to bring in the new year with a drive for better health and waistlines, we invite you to bring your own home-made cakes to make any tsuki targets a little more prominent.

Naturally we want to effectively COVID19 risk so we would ask all attendees to:

1. Ensure your vaccinations are up to date
2. Carry out a lateral flow test just before you set off for the event
3. Do not attend if you show any cold, flu or COVID symptoms
4. Wear masks when entering the building, getting changed and moving through facility
5. Try to maintain some physical distancing where possible
6. Dress warmly as we will be having the windows open
7. Maintain some distancing when/if a central demonstration is held
8. Use only your own weapons or clean weapons at any exchange
9. Use hand sanitiser during the day
10. Be ready to train in smaller groups or pairs if necessary

On registration at the morning of the first day you attend, you will be required to show **either**:

- A valid **"Covid Pass"** which will be scanned and checked using the government's "Verifier" app at registration (no personal data is stored during this process).
- A paper "Covid Pass" with a valid expiry date **or** an Immunisation Exemption Certificate.
- If you are exempt or not fully vaccinated by the time of the seminar, a valid Test Result (PCR or LFT) will be accepted (no older than 4 days prior to your first training session).
- A "Double Jab" Immunisation Card/Certificate (second jab to have been received 14 days or more prior to the event).

**By signing up for the event, you will be agreeing to these conditions**

Failure to meet these conditions on the morning of the event means that unfortunately you will not be allowed to participate.

I would emphasise that the best COVID preventative we have is making sure that no one at the event has COVID so I stress the importance of not attending if you are showing any COVID symptoms and to do a lateral flow test before you depart for the event.
