COVID-19: ATTENDANCE CONDITIONS & ADVICE

The government has relaxed Covid-19 precautions and so we will not be asking for a negative test result on registration at the seminar. However we **strongly recommend taking one the evening before or the morning of your first day of attending**. Everyone should make their own Health & Safety evaluation and act responsibly.

- do not attend if you have any Covid-like symptoms. Seminar refunds/credits are available in these circumstances.
- please be aware of others in indoor, enclosed spaces. Wearing a face covering is not mandatory but is encouraged, especially in areas of higher risk e.g changing facilities, doorways.
- do not invite guests to the seminar, including to observe the grading.

During the seminar try to maintain distancing whenever possible, especially if observing a teacher (shugo).



VENUE

Kingsdown School: Hyde Rd, Swindon SN2 7SH



There are two sites close together on B4006 Hyde Road. The 'Old' Gym (Jodo) is on the school campus. The Sports Hall and Dance Studio (laido) are in the Sports Centre a short distance away.

Access by car: Access by car is via the M4 (E&W) and M40 and A420 from North

Parking: Free parking onsite. On Sunday <u>everyone</u> should park at the Sports Centre.

Grading applications must be completed online and the grading question paper submitted to the laido grading officer **no later than 25**th **of February.** Grading Questions should be sent to: <u>iaidograding@britishkendoassociation.com</u>.

JODO

Gradings, up to 3rd dan will be held on the Sunday afternoon before the laido grading. Grading applications must be completed online and the grading question paper submitted to the Jodo grading officer **no later than 2**nd **of March.** Grading Questions should be sent to: jodograding@britishkendoassociation.com.

Non-BKA members are requested to either register online through the seminar booking process and pay beforehand, or inform the Grading Officer of your wish to grade if you have problems booking online. You will also need to provide a letter of permission from your own federation to take part in the grading.

BOOKING

BKA Members

Please book onto this event through the online booking system by going through your <u>account</u>. You will need to add items to your basket and return to the booking screen to add accommodation nights, sayonara party booking etc where relevant. Please make sure that you have booked:

- 1. The correct seminar booking.
- 2. The correct grading if you are grading.

If you have any problems with the online booking system, please contact the relevant Events Officer.

If you have a credit from a previous event do not book online. Instead email the Jodo/laido Events Officer who will manually add your name to the list.

Overseas visitors only

You can now book onto the event via the BKA website online registration system as a "guest member". To do this you will need to:

- 2. Make sure that you have logged out of any existing membership from previous years.

- 3. Register a User Name and Password, email address and submit.
- 4. You will receive a link in your email. Click on this to confirm.
- 5. You will be directed to a page to enter your full details. You will then be allowed to book onto the events required (follow BKA members instructions from there on).

CANCELLATION AND REFUND

IAIDO

Cancellations for personal reasons must be received in writing (email) by 2nd of March for a full refund.

JODO

Cancellations must be received in writing (email) by 2nd of March for a full refund.

If you do not cancel or do not attend the event, no refunds will be made.

You can transfer your seminar place to another person providing the event relevant Event Officer is notified, and that person completes an application form (this can be done on the day). Alternatively, by agreement, your fee can be transferred to the next event of equivalent cost.
